Connecting Downtown Restaurants to Camas Trails

Welcome to the Camas Trails to Tables Challenge! What better way to celebrate the start of Summer than by exploring your local trails and enjoying a delicious meal. Get in on the fun and challenge yourself to connect our city trails to our downtown tables!

## Trails



- Walk the five trails listed below (answer the trivia questions by writing below the question.)
- Dine at any five of the participating restaurants listed on the back of this brochure (get your restaurant square stamped)
- When completed, turn in your passport to receive a Trails to Tables custom glass and be entered to win a Downtown Camas prize basket valued at \$250! (see back of brochure for drop-off instructions)

The trails are all located within or near the City of Camas limits. Drive or walk to Downtown Camas and treat yourself to a delicious meal. **Heritage Trail (T1)** - Trailhead begins at the west end of the Heritage Park parking lot off NE Lake Rd. This easy, dirt/gravel, ADA accessible trail extends 3.5 miles to Goodwin Rd. But for this Challenge, you'll walk .9 miles to the overlook and pier, then choose to return for a 1.8 mile walk or continue along the trail with large trees, native plants and extensive views of Lacamas Lake.

- *What color is the majority of the bench legs?*
- *Is there a roof over the lake overlook?*

**Round Lake Loop - Lacamas Park (T4)** - After parking in the main lot (limited) on NE Everett or in the overflow lot off NE 35th, start your hike from the park's main entry point. Following the trail in a counter-clockwise direction will take you on a 1.5 mile round trip. The compacted gravel trail is easy with moderate hills, but not considered ADA accessible due to obstacles (the dam) and hills.

- *When were the fish screens placed in operation? (hint: look for the fish screen historical board near the main dam)*

- *Why is there a boot cleaner at the "Play, Clean, Go" sign?*

**Downtown Camas Bronze Birds "Trail"** - Download the Downtown Bronze Bird map at <https://downtowncamas.com/dca/donate-2/bronze-bird-tour> and have fun finding all 14 feathered friends.

- *Which bird is located near the US Post Office?*

- *Where can the Goose, created by Mike Smith, be found?*

**Washougal River Greenway (WRG) (T6)** - Access from Baz River Front Park off NE 3rd Loop. Easy, paved 1.1 mile trail scenic trail teeming with wildlife and water views. ADA Accessible.

- *What bird might you see catching fish in the Washougal River?*

- *Who is the WRG Bridge dedicated to? (hint: look for the metal plaque at the mid-point of the bridge)*

**Port of Camas-Washougal Waterfront Trail** - Access from S. 1st St. in Washougal, this community favorite walk-way is an easy, paved 1.2 mile (round trip) trail that meanders along the Columbia River and past the popular Natural Play Area. If you choose to walk further East via the public sidewalk, you'll connect to the Columbia River Dike Trail, another local trail gem. ADA Accessible.

- *Name one of the musical instruments you can play in the Play Area.*

- *Who built the life-vest cabinet located at the non-motorized boat launch at the beginning of the trail? (hint: look for the plaque)*
