

The Camas Hotel

Built in 1911, the Camas Hotel is the oldest commercial building in Camas, surviving the town-wide fire in 1923. In its early days, it was described as being “modern in every respect”.



It originally was called the **Commercial Hotel** because the name of “Camas Hotel” was already taken by the hotel down the street (where Journey Community Church now stands). When the original Camas Hotel closed, the Commercial Hotel changed its name.

The Camas Hotel was renovated in 2009 and is reminiscent of a European boutique hotel with on site gourmet restaurant and glass atrium.
