Guidelines for Artists

Little Art Camas is a community exhibit of original artworks made by local artists. Help support future downtown art projects by entering 3 “little” art pieces into this fun and meaningful art exhibit! All ages and skill levels welcome.

This event celebrates local art, makes original art available to everyone and encourages art appreciation and art collecting for all.

Little Art Camas is hosted by the Downtown Camas Association in the beautiful Fuel Medical Building Lobby, 314 NE Birch, in Downtown Camas.

Registration is open to the first 150 creators. Thank you for being part of Little Art Camas!

Interested in donating to The Little Art Camas Silent Auction? We are currently seeking donations of original art from local artists. We would love to accept every piece donated, but we have limited space available. If you're interested in submitting a piece of work for the auction, please send an image of the work to promotions@downtowncamas.com. The auction pieces will be chosen by the Little Art Camas Silent Auction Committee. Thank you for your consideration!

How to participate

There is a \$15 fee to participate which covers the cost of the three panels for submission. Print and fill out application form, [Click Here for the Application](#)

Artwork must be created directly on or affixed to the panels provided. Each artist will receive three panels, with required identification labels to attach, per registration. Identification tags will be provided for each panel to affix to the backside when submitted. In the interest of fairness for those buying art, entries will not necessarily be displayed together. We encourage creating pieces that can be displayed separately.

Panel sizes are: one 5”x 5”, one 5”x 7”, one 8”x 8”. You are free to exchange sizes with other artists as long as all art pieces are returned.

How to submit your art

Artwork may not exceed the edges of the panels provided and 3D works may not exceed 2.0 inches in depth including the panel. You may create directly on the panel or mount your work securely to the panel.

Original art only please. Works may not be copied from any published artwork or photograph. Copyright to your work belongs to you as the artist. Information can be found here: <https://www.copyright.gov/circs/circ01.pdf>

No glitter or unfixed charcoal/pastels please as these may affect other nearby art.

It is very important for the show that you submit your art! If you are unable to complete your art pieces, let us know as soon as possible so we can give the opportunity to another artist. Thank you!

PLEASE NOTE: The DCA reserves the right to exclude any works with respect to suitability for this community-oriented exhibit. We wish to be considerate of artists and viewers with this all-ages event. The DCA will contact the artist personally to discuss any work in question.

How the art sale works

All artwork entered in **Little Art Camas** will be priced at **\$20** with no NFS (Not for Sale) works accepted.

Works will be displayed Friday evening and Saturday with some works held for Saturday display for the "Saturday Refresh". See the Event Schedule section below.

Photography is allowed during the exhibit.

How to drop off your art

Artists will drop off the **entry forms** along with their three unique works. These serve as the donation forms to the Downtown Camas Association, host of the exhibit. Works must have the provided **identification tag** firmly attached to the backside, in the lower left corner.

Art Drop Off: From Wednesday, March 11th to Wednesday, March 18th, all artwork must be received through in-person drop off at the locations listed. Late entries cannot be accepted or displayed and early drop off is appreciated.

How to label your artwork

Each work **MUST** have the provided identification label taped securely to the backside.

Please fill in all the fields of the art entry form and submit with each art piece.

You may also put a business card or similar information on the piece that will stay with it when sold.

How the art will be displayed

Works will be installed by DCA staff and volunteers and will not be visibly labeled during the show.

We cannot guarantee where any work will be displayed in the exhibit or in relation to other works. In the interest of fairness for those buying art, entries will not necessarily be displayed together. We encourage creating pieces that can be displayed separately. Artwork is not insured by the DCA.

Awards? You bet!

Prizes will be awarded for Judge's Choice for both Adult and 18 & Under categories.

How to retrieve or donate your art

Any unsold works may be retrieved by the artist during the published pick up times (see schedule below).

Please have someone pick up for you if you are not able to come during those times.

Works not reclaimed by the artist by the stated deadline are considered a donation and become the property of the DCA. Thank you! Art may be donated, sold or put to another use at the organization's discretion.
