

Camas Plein Air Art Event

Presentation

Artwork must be framed and ready to hang. Unframed artwork will be accepted as long as the canvas is wrapped, finished (painted), void of staples and 1 ½ "deep. Artwork done on board must have finished edges. Drawings (pen and ink/graphite/conté or charcoal) and watercolors must be framed, matted and have glass to protect the surface.

Sales

You may choose to donate your artwork to be auctioned off at the Dinner In White event on September 7th at the Port of Camas-Washougal. If you would like this option, please indicate so on your entry form. 100% of the proceeds will go to benefit the Washougal Library Building Fund. If you do not want to donate your artwork, then you may choose to display your piece in the Camas Art Gallery through the month of September. If you choose option #2, your artwork would have a retail price set at \$200. If your art sells, you would receive \$100 and the Camas Gallery would receive \$100. If your artwork does not sell, we ask that you pick your artwork up from the Camas Gallery by October 4th.

Eligibility – Definition – Rules

1. Anyone can enter the Camas Plein Air Art Event.
2. At least 75% of the painting/drawing must be completed on site and outdoors to be considered "Plein Air" (25% of the art surface can be prepared in advance).
3. Subject matter must be limited to the Downtown Camas area. This encompasses Garfield Street to the paper mill and 2nd Avenue to 6th Avenue. This provides subjects ranging from architectural elements, buildings (including the paper mill), residential homes, statues, trees, flora/fauna and animals.
4. Entry forms are on the Camas Gallery website at www.camasgallery.com, or available in the Gallery at 408 NE 4th.
5. Artists can begin working at 9am. All work must be completed and brought to the Camas Gallery by 4:30pm.
6. Artist can position themselves on the sidewalks, but must be mindful of allowing 4 feet of unobstructed area for foot traffic to pass in the downtown core.
7. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will receive a People's Choice Award determined by a vote of the people attending the event. Winners will be announced at 7:30pm.
8. Please notify the Camas Gallery as to the location where you will be working. This can be done at the time of registration, or once you arrive in Camas and have made your selection.
